Lunch: meet the participants

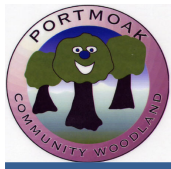

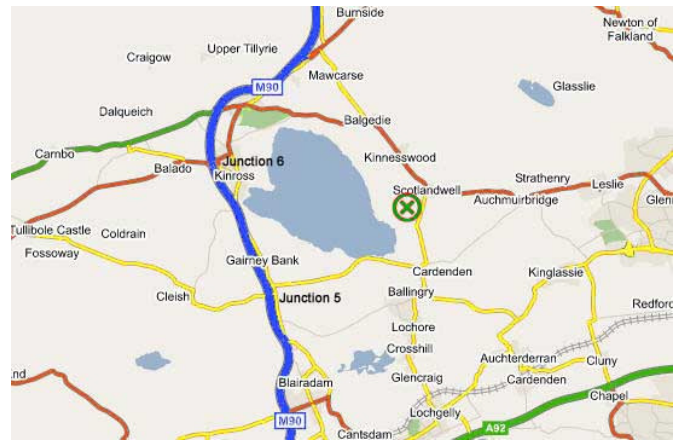
Find us in one of these ways

Our areas of Community Woodland are easily accessible from the villages of Scotlandwell and Kinnesswood, in Perth and Kinross district. The nearest towns are Kinross and Milnathort, about 8 or 9 miles away, both on the M90. We are about midway between the Forth Road Bridge and Perth
